

2024 RESERVE MERLOT



SITE:

Our 2024 Merlot was farmed by our new friends in the Horse Heaven Hills region of southern Washington State. The grapes were picked and express shipped in small containers across the 49th overnight to our crush pad where our winemaking team was able to put their own individual stamp on the finished wine.

NOTES:

A ripe, full-bodied Merlot that showcases aromas and flavours of black cherry, clove, and blackberry compote. Extended barrel maturation lends savoury notes of saddle leather and tobacco.

VARIETY:

100% Merlot

CELLAR:

Aged in French oak for 14 months, 15% of which was new.

HARVESTED:

October 2024
